## KEY SKILLS FOR DEVELOPMENT/ASSESSMENT FOCUS

Term	Year 10 : Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing	Year11 : Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing
Term 1	<i>Past tense formation, consolidation of regular and irregular present tense verbs Future tense introduced. Revision of KS3 Food and Drink vocabulary.</i>	Development of listening and reading skills, consolidation of verbs, key phrases for role play
Term 2	<i>Verb consolidation in three tenses. Sport vocabulary revisited and extended. Use of connectives when and if.</i>	Exam strategies and revision techniques concentrating on topics seen to need revisiting following internal exam. Grammar consolidation.
Term 3	<i>Revision of past tense and introduction of vocabulary related to new technology</i>	Revision of topics covered in Year 9, focusing on 4 key skills and exam questions.
Term 4	<i>Imperfect tense. Reflexive verbs. Introduction of vocabulary related to Customs and Festivals</i>	Lessons delivered to address misconceptions and areas for development. Vocabulary revision and key phrases.
Term 5	<i>Modal verbs linked to behaviour, Past tense revision, “If” sentences, recognition and use of subjunctive.</i>	Past paper practice, exam strategies and consolidation of vocabulary.
Term 6	<i>Revision of key verbs in different tenses, consolidation of agreement of adjectives and other grammar points in preparation for end of year exam.</i>	

## OTHER INFORMATION/ HOMEWORK / INDEPENDENT STUDY

Assessments take place throughout the year, and are in the style of the new GCSE. All four skills are covered over the year.

Students also complete key pieces of work which are graded and moderated.

In order to be successful, students will need to spend time on a regular basis learning new vocabulary and revising previously covered work at home. In addition, reading, listening and writing tasks will be set for students to produce independently.
