

DIOCESE OF SALFORD
INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT
MOUNT ST JOSEPH CATHOLIC SCHOOL

1. The name of the school is Mount St Joseph Catholic School.
2. The school was founded by and is part of the Catholic Church. The school is to be conducted as a Catholic School in accordance with the canon law and teachings of the Roman Catholic Church, and in accordance with the Trust Deed of the Diocese of Salford and in particular:
 - a) religious education is to be in accordance with the teachings, doctrines, discipline and general particular norms of the Catholic Church;
 - b) religious worship is to be in accordance with the rites, practices, discipline and liturgical norms of the Catholic Church;and at all times the school is to serve as a witness to the Catholic faith in Our Lord Jesus Christ.
3. The school is a voluntary aided school.
4. The name of the governing body is "The Governing Body of Mount St Joseph Catholic School".
5. The governing body shall consist of:
 - (a) 2 parent governors;
 - (b) 1 local authority governor;
 - (c) 1 staff governor;
 - (d) 1 head teacher;
 - (e) 7 foundation governors;
6. Total number of governors: 12
7. Foundation governors shall be appointed and may be removed by the Bishop of Salford (or any other person exercising jurisdiction on his behalf).
8. This instrument of government comes into effect on 8 May 2017.
9. This instrument was made by order of Bolton Council on 2017.
10. A copy of the instrument must be supplied to every member of the governing body (and the head teacher if not a governor), any trustees and to the appropriate religious body.

11. The Instrument of Government for Mount St Joseph Business and Enterprise College made on 11 April 2012 is revoked with effect from 7 May 2017.
