

Job description:

House Captains - Student Council Representatives.

MSJ Student Council is a body of approx. thirty students to be made up of House Captains from all year groups in all houses, with two House Captains per year group, per house.

Student Councillors / House Captains must:

- 1. Represent their house at school council meetings with commitment and full attendance.
- 2. Report back to their houses with any relevant information during assemblies.
- 4. Lead assemblies, or sections of assemblies, including prayers.
- 5. Believe in the importance of representing their house's and the student council's point of view even if they do not agree with it themselves.
- 6. Initiate discussion and debate with fellow student representatives and understand the importance of teamwork.
- 7. Understand that as a school council representative, they have the obligation to participate in making decisions about the school, along with staff and school governors.
- 8. Represent the students of Mount St Joseph High School at important public occasions.
- 9. Attend all school council meetings. If there is a justifiable reason ensure that an adequate stand-in from their tutor/year group is present.
- 10. Engage positively in meetings in order to drive forward the house system and house competitions.
- 11. Act as student mentors, especially for the younger years and at transition events, visiting forms and helping students with reading and other activities
- 12. Lead their house in house competitions.
- 13. Maintain the display board for their house.
- 14. Design banners and mascots to be used in house assemblies and house competitions, including sports day.
- 15. Report to staff and senior leaders at staff briefings, SLT meetings and other staff meetings where appropriate.
- 16. Compile a half termly newsletter to inform staff and students about the school council and their role.
