Kilo

The root **kilo** comes from the Greek language. It means “thousand”.

Kilobyte – A unit of memory or data (equal to 1,024 bytes).

Kilogram – A unit of mass (equal to 1000 grams), first introduced as a unit of mass for the metric system in 1965

Kilometre – A unit of length (equal to 1000 metres).
