## Careers Week: Monday 8th February - Friday 12th February 2021

I hope you and your families are keeping well. As you are aware, every year Mount St Joseph hosts a careers week for all our Year 7-11 students in the last week of the February half term. Although our community cannot be in school altogether and we are unable to invite guest speakers into school, we still think it is vital for our students to learn about the different careers and the skills required for their future.

Our very first virtual Careers week will run from **Monday 8<sup>th</sup> February- Friday 12<sup>th</sup> February)**, this also includes a 'Careers and Aspirations Day' on T**hursday, 11th February**, where students will participate in career-based lessons and activities, rather than their normal curriculum timetable they have been following whilst working at home.

Evidence shows that young people do start to develop their aspirations and ideas about careers long before they are ready to join the labour market therefore, it is important that we provide our students the opportunity to consider their futures and the skills, qualities and qualifications they may need to develop whilst at school in order to follow their dreams.

The careers week will focus on broadening horizons and raising aspirations, giving our students a wide range of experiences of the world including the world of work. We want to show our students the vast range of possibilities open to them and helping to keep their options open for as long as possible.

For students in Year 7-8, there is a range of attributes, skills, and behaviours that can be encouraged at this early stage of a child's secondary education that will leave them in the best possible position as they begin their transitions to GCSEs and to future life.

For Year 9-11 students, the aim of the week is to give our students the opportunity to consider their career pathway carefully and with as much high-quality information, advice and guidance as possible. There is greater emphasis on understanding the importance of and acquiring key employability skills, and an in-depth look at the labour market and possible career pathways.



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The Careers and Aspirations Day for Year 9-11 will include a careers fair which consists of a wide selection of short videos (4 - 7 minutes long) covering many different careers and education pathways that students will view from home via links accessed through Microsoft One Drive. We have a host of different local employers and education providers sharing their experiences. This will be an opportunity for students to understand the qualifications required, salary, responsibilities and duties of specific careers.

Careers Education forms an integral part of your child's education in ensuring they are ready for their life after school and the world of work. The careers week plan is detailed on the following page. We would really appreciate it if all our parents and carers could support and encourage their child to participate in the careers week activities and events.
